## **COP26 is the perfect time to learn how to take climate action in Aotearoa New Zealand**

All eyes will be on the UN Climate Change Conference, COP26, in the UK next month. To give New Zealand businesses the tools, plan and a pathway for climate action, the Sustainable Business Network (SBN) is partnering with the British High Commission to deliver a series of nationwide climate action workshops.

The British High Commission wants to raise awareness of and engage more New Zealand businesses in the UN-backed global campaign [Race to Zero](#) programme. It calls on all non-government organisations to commit to action to halve their emissions by 2030 and go net zero by 2050. This will help maintain a stable climate, one which protects the health and wellbeing of all people.

The workshops will be run by Phil Jones, SBN's Programme Manager for Climate Action. He says "some businesses are leading the way and are already on the net-zero pathway but we have to get many more businesses to start the process. That's what these workshops are designed to do."

Reducing emissions rapidly requires targets and actions from government, businesses and individuals. In these workshops, SBN will guide businesses through the Climate Action Toolbox, which provides a practical understanding of what businesses can do. The Toolbox is a free self-assessment tool hosted on [business.govt.nz](https://business.govt.nz) that makes it easy for businesses to take action on climate.

The changing climate requires all businesses, no matter how small, to take steps to reduce their emissions. The interactive workshops, held online in five regions, will inspire businesses to up their game.

They will also provide:

- A practical understanding of actions a business can take to reduce its emissions.

- A tailored action plan, containing simple steps to reduce a business's carbon emissions using the free online [\*Climate Action Toolbox\*](#).
- Help from SBN and British High Commission climate experts on setting targets, such as looking at [\*Race to Zero\*](#) – a global campaign rallying businesses to take urgent climate action.
- Guidance from the SBN team on how to build confidence and create change in the business.
- Provide a place to share ideas and connect with business leaders.
